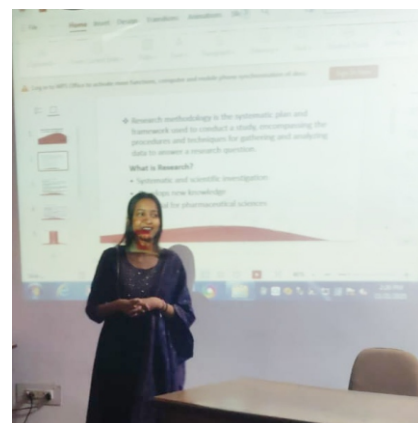
DIWALI CELEBRATION 17 OCTOBER 2025

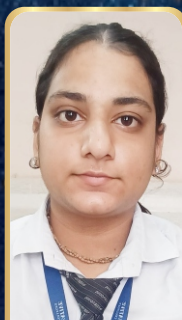
FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (FDP) – 25–30 MAY 2026

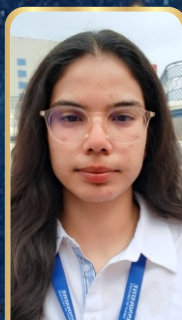

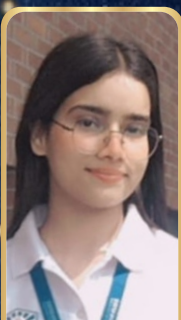

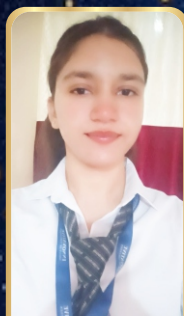
